NEW BUSINESS

EMERGENCY READING OF AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING FOR OR AGAINST THE RECALL OF COUNCILMEMBER JIM DEPAUW, REPRESENTING DISTRICT 6; DESIGNATING POLLING PLACE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE NOTICE AND HAVE THE NOTICE POSTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOTIFYING THE PUBLIC OF SAID ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
