McMAHON/WRINKLE AIRPARK DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Three Year Term – Expires 9-30

Membership should be composed of members of the City of Big Spring or Howard County who have demonstrated their interest and knowledge of business, industry and real estate. One (1) member of the Airpark Development Board shall be the Chairman of the Airpark Safety Committee. The Chairman of the Airpark Safety Committee shall be a **permanent** member of the Board.

Ex-officio Members: Administrative Assistant to the Air Park
President of the Big Spring Economic Development Board
(No Voting Power)

BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS & APPEALS

Three Year Term – Expires 9-30

Membership should be a citizen of the City of Big Spring. If unable to find a person with requirement from the City of Big Spring, a citizen of Howard County with requirement can serve. Should have one of each composed of:

- (1) Engineer or Architect
- (1) Mechanical Contractor
- (1) Master Electrician
- (1) Master Plumber
- (3) Members at large from the construction field

(2) Ex-officio Members – Representatives of Atmos and TXU Electric

CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU BOARD

1. Two (2) City Council Members each of who shall be appointed by a majority vote of the City Council and shall be subject to reappointment following their re-election to their respective council seats.
2. One (1) member of the Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors who shall be appointed by members of the Chamber Board and shall serve a term of three years coinciding with his/her term on the Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.
3. Three (3) at-large members appointed by Majority Vote of the City Council to serve a term of 3 years.
4. One at-large member from the local hotel industry appointed by Majority Vote of Council.

The City Manager and Director of Finance of the City of Big Spring who shall serve in advisory capacity as ex-officio, non-voting members of the Board.

The Community Services Director shall serve as staff liaison to the Convention & Visitors Bureau Board and shall act as Secretary of the Board and shall be responsible for keeping the minutes and other official records of the Board.

PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

Three Year Term – Expires 9-30

Consists of seven (7) at-large members at least five (5) of whom reside within the city limits of Big Spring.

PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION

Three Year Term – Expires 9-30

Consists of seven (7) at-large members who reside within the city limits of Big Spring.

TRAFFIC COMMISSION

Three Year Term – Expires 9-30

Consists of seven (7) at-large members, all of whom reside within the city limits of Big Spring.

ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS:

Three Year Term – Expires 9-30

Consist of five (5) at-large members who reside within the city limits of Big Spring and two (2) alternates.

BIG SPRING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

Three Year Term – Expires 9-30

Elected officials of the City, county, state or federal governments are ineligible to serve as directors.

Each Director shall meet at least one (1) of the following qualifications and no member of the Board shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms:

1. Serve, or have served, as Chief Executive Officer of a company; or
2. Serve, or have served, in a position of Executive Management of a company or
3. Serve, or have served, in a professional capacity; or
4. Have experience equivalent to any of the above qualifications.

CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

Three Year Term – Expires 9-30

This Commission is appointed by the City Manager and confirmed by City Council.

COLORADO RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Two Year Term – Expires 5-31

BIG SPRING HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Two Year Term – Expires 9-30

This Commission is appointed by the Mayor.

Program Participant – Federal Rule – All Commissioners term expire every two years. All can be reappointed and serve unlimited terms, except the Resident Commissioner.

The Resident Commissioner can only serve two consecutive terms (4years) and has to be currently on the Housing Program.

If there is a vacant Commissioner spot, then the Resident Commissioner can be appointed to fill that vacancy and another current resident can be appointed to fill the vacant Resident Commissioner's spot. Commissioner Handbook of March 2002 Edition

HOWARD COUNTY 911 COMMUNICATION DISTRICT

Five (5) Voting Member Board and one (1) Non-Voting Member Appointed

- Two (2) members appointed by Howard County Commissioner's Court
- Two (2) by all incorporated cities within the county
- One (1) non-voting member is appointed by the largest telephone service provider within the county
