Re: City Offices Closed for the Independence Day Holiday

All City of Big Spring offices will be closed on Monday, July 4, 2022, for Independence Day.

There will be no sanitation pickup on Monday, July 4th. Monday's normal sanitation routes will be picked up on Tuesday, July 5th. Tuesday's normal sanitation routes will be picked up on Wednesday, July 6th. Thursday and Friday sanitation routes will proceed as usual.

The City Landfill will also be closed on Monday, July 4th. The landfill will be open on Saturday, July 2nd, for normal business hours, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

The Russ McEwen Aquatic Center will be closed on Sunday, July 3rd to help with staging for Pops in the Park. The Aquatic Center will be open to the public on Monday, July 4th from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Moss Creek Lake will be open to the public during the holiday. Citizens are reminded that pursuant to City Ordinance the discharge of firearms or fireworks of any kind within the Moss Creek Lake facility or on the lake property is strictly prohibited.

Emergency services (Police, Fire, and EMS) will continue normal operations. The Emergency Utilities Department will also be available and can be reached by calling 432-264-2392.
