Re: City Offices Closed for the Independence Day Holiday

All City of Big Spring offices will be closed on Friday, July 4, 2025, for Independence Day. There will be no sanitation pickup on Friday, July 4th. Monday and Tuesday sanitation routes will be picked up as usual. End of the week pick up will be a day early. Thursday sanitation routes will be picked up on Wednesday and Friday's routes will be picked up on Thursday. The landfill will also be closed on Friday, July 4th. The landfill will be open for normal business hours on Saturday, July 5th.

The Russ McEwen Aquatic Center will be closed on Wednesday, July 3rd to help with staging for Pops in the Park. The Aquatic Center will be open to the public on Friday, July 4th from 1 pm to 6 pm.

Moss Creek Lake will be open to the public during the holiday. Citizens are reminded that pursuant to City Ordinance the discharge of firearms or fireworks of any kind within the Moss Creek Lake facility or on the lake property is strictly prohibited.
